RIDER NOTES

- **Bikes must be clean before entering the track.**
- Your machine is a valuable investment. Please ensure your bike and equipment is securely stored at all times.
- Riders must wear protective clothing, boots and helmets & provide own water bottle.
- Please no 'tear offs'
- **NO GLASS** allowed in the camping area.
- Noise curfew: **Bikes** - 6pm to 7am AND **Camp** - after 10pm
- Riders must not consume alcohol prior to the event.
- Liquor is permitted within the campsite area but must not be removed from the area - **no glass** is permitted
- **Participants are liable to alcohol and drug testing**
- No riding is permitted through camp area
- Camp Security will be present with public nuisances required to leave and face the possibility of being banned from future ride events
- **No campfires allowed**
- **No dogs allowed**
- Showers and toilet facilities available

CAMPING AREA AVAILABLE AT START SITE

A canteen will operate at the start site with BBQ meals from Saturday until lunch on Sunday, cold drinks, tea and coffee, etc.
