Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- Establish a clear improvement agenda with an explicit focus on student outcomes to guide teaching and learning and provide clarity for student learning, achievement and improvement.
- Implement curriculum co-planning opportunities, led by the leadership team, to foster greater teacher knowledge, understanding and confidence of the Australian Curriculum.
- Collaboratively establish a collegial engagement framework to support opportunities for teachers to receive feedback, reflect on and strengthen their pedagogical practices.
- Collaboratively build effective whole-school approaches to leading and teaching literacy that align to the explicit improvement agenda, and sets clear expectations and builds clarity of understanding and consistency for teachers, to support every student to realise their potential.
- Develop a whole-school pedagogical approach for teaching literacy to provide consistency and support a universal lift to student outcomes.
